Veterans Day Run 2020

Update

In light of the widespread cancellations of Veterans Day parades and other celebrations across the state due to health safety concerns, the American Legion Riders District 9 of Contra Costa County will co-host a motorcycle run with ALR District 10 of Alameda County through several downtown areas across their respective districts on Wednesday, November 11th, 2020.

The purpose of this run is to honor and celebrate the American Veterans across our two counties without inviting or incurring large public gatherings. An undetermined number of motorcycles shall proceed at normal traffic speeds flying American flags past various Veterans buildings and memorial sites and through downtown regions along a pre-determined route. It is not anticipated that riders will stop to interact with the public at any point, with the exception of a meal stop in downtown Danville.
